an Ayurvedic College at Sangli, from  
the year 1981-82.

Sir,

I am directed to state that Vasantrao Banduji Patil Trust, Sangli has decided to start an Ayurvedic College (B.A.M.S. Degree Course) at Sangli. The Government has considered the request and has decided that the Trust should be granted permission to start the College on the specific condition that no grant-in-aid will be paid by the Government to the College for the period of 10 years. I am accordingly to communicate Government's approval, under section 43(4 & 5) of the Shivaji University Act, 1974, for processing by the University the application of the Society for starting an Ayurvedic College at Sangli from the academic year 1981-82. The Society is being instructed to apply to the University as required under Section 43 for affiliation, if it has not applied so far.

2. In view of the short time left for the commencement of the ensuing academic year, the University is requested to permit the management to start the College. The proposal of the University for final approval of Government under section 43(6 & 7) may be forwarded to the Government along with the reports of the Local Enquiry Committee, Academic Council, Executive Council and the Senate in due course. This may please be treated as 'Immediate'.

**RESOLUTION:** Government have already issued orders under Government  
Resolution, Medical Education and Drugs Department No. ADR-1081/1175/  
MED-7, dated the 10th October 1984 that Vasantdada Patil Ayurveda  
Mahavidyalaya, Sangli, should be made eligible to receive recurring  
grant-in-aid from State Government with effect from the current  
financial year 1984-85, according to the same pattern, rules, norms,  
procedure and orders applicable to the other Ayurvedic teaching  
colleges in State from time to time. Sanction is, therefore, accorded  
to the payment of grant-in-aid amounting to Rs. 1,00,000/-  
(~~Rs. One Lakh only~~), to Vasantdada Patil Ayurvedic College, Sangli

2. The amount of grant-in-aid to the Vasantdada Patil Ayurveda,  
Mahavidyalaya, Sangli, is sanctioned subject to the following  
conditions and adjustment of any excess grants later on -

- (i) that if it is observed that the appointments have not been made by the authorities of the Institutions as per conditions of C.C.I.M./Government, then whole amount of payment to the institution for such person(s) is subject to recovery.
- (ii) that the payment of grant-in-aid to the Institution shall be adjusted in the final instalment of recurring grant-in-aid that will be admissible to the institution on their accounts for the year 1984-85.
- (iii) that the accounts of the institution/parent body together with all the relevant papers are produced for verification by Accountant General I/Maharashtra, Bombay, Deputy Chief Auditor Local Funds Accounts, Bombay and by the authorities of the Ayurvedic Departments if so, required by them.
- (iv) the authorities of the institution should clear the payment of salaries first to the eligible non-teaching staff.
- (v) the authorities of the institution should disburse payment of salaries to the staff of their institution in the presence of the concerned Assistant Director of Ayurved Pune or his representative or Extension Officer in Ayurved posted at the Zilla Parishad under intimation to the Director of Ayurved as well as to the Government. The Assistant Director of Ayurved is permitted to utilise the services of the Extension Officer in Ayurved.

3. The expenditure on this account should be debited to the Budget Head, "280-Medical-B-Other Systems of Medicines-a-Ayurvedic-a-8 schemes in the Five Year Plan-a-3-(7) Grant-in-aid to Ayurvedic and Unani Institutions (2801657) and should be met from the sanctioned grants of Rs. 2,43,000/- under Demand No. 192 kept at the disposal of the Directorate of Ayurved during financial year 1984-85.

4. This Resolution issues vide Planning Department and Finance Department's un-official reference Nos. 298-PRG-12, dated 28th January 1985 and C.F. No. 93/85/EXP-13, dated the 29th January 1985 respectively.
