ENVIRONMENTAL CLEANING

For Linen

- Washable washing with warm water at 60-90°C. The laundry can then be dried according to routine procedures.
- If machine washing is not possible, items can be soaked in hot water and then in a large drum using a stick to stir and being careful to avoid splashing.
- The drum should then be emptied and the water soaked at 90°C, cleaning for approximately 30 minutes.
- Finally, the laundry should be rinsed with clean water and the items allowed to dry fully or sunlight.
- Follow proper hand hygiene after every work procedure.
